BRIEF AND QUESTIONNAIRE ON MAKE PROJECT

- 1. <u>Proposal</u> It is proposed to design, develop and manufacture **Transition Platform with Trailer** through indigenous private industry in India. Successfully developed equipment will subsequently be procured by the IAF under Make II procedure of Chapter III, DAP 2020.
- 2. <u>Broad Requirements</u>. Transition Platforms are utilized for movement of fuselage from one location to another. These are universal platform and are suitable for different aircraft of similar weight category. The instant case is to indigenously design, develop and manufacture **Trailers with Transition Platform** as per the Make II procedure of Chap III, DAP 2020. Broad specifications are: -
 - (a) Capacity 90/40/16 Ton
 - (b) Equipped with bore holes for easy attachment of wing and fuselage transition.
 - (c) Equipped with 8 swivel axles to compensate for uneven terrain. During mechanical steering, all axle lines are affected due to steering rods.
 - (d) Towing can be performed from both sides of the trailer.
 - (e) Equipped with parking brakes to avoid movement during storage.
- 3. <u>Broad Timelines</u>. The prototype development is expected to be completed within one year of Project Sanction Order. Other estimated timelines are as follow:-

(a)	Time period for response from industry	Six weeks (may extend)
(b)	Interaction with vendors and feasibility study	Eight weeks
(c)	If project found feasible, internal approvals and issue of Eol	Eight weeks (may extend)

4. **Quantity.** Industry may propose number of prototypes that will need to be developed for demonstration of full capability. During procurement phase, tentative 50 quantities are likely to be procured by the IAF (these are indicative quantities only. Exact quantities will be intimated during issue of EoI).
