GLIDEFIRE SSM UNDER MAKE-II CATEGORY

- 1. <u>Name of the Proposal</u>. Glidefire SSM for Indian Navy under Make II procedure of DAP 2020.
- 2. <u>User Directorate</u>. Directorate of Staff Requirements, Integrated Headquarters of Ministry of Defence (Navy).
- 3. <u>Broad Description</u>. The Glidefire Surface to Surface Missile (SSM) is intended to be a new induction, lightweight, modular and cost effective missile solution to target enemy ships/ land targets. The missile would use hybrid propulsion and unique controllable surfaces to undertake precise engagement of enemy targets. The Glidefire SSM is intended to be launched from a modular scalable launcher from Indian Naval Ships including the existing Universal Vertical Launcher Module fitted on IN Ships. The associated systems of the weapon complex include Fire Control System, Launcher, Connectors, Cables and interface with ship borne systems.
- 4. <u>Tentative Quantity and Prototypes</u>. A total of two prototypes and about 100 Glidefire SSMs would be required by the Indian Navy. The quantity indicated for prototype and production is only an indicative requirement and is not a firm commitment. The quantity has been provided so as to enable firms to arrive at economy of scale prior providing statement of cost of production version Glidefire SSM.
- 5. <u>Tentative Cost</u>. To be determined post interaction with vendors.
- 6. <u>Developmental Timelines</u>. To be determined post interaction with vendors.
